The engines have been serviced and raw-water pumps have been replaced, reflecting the owner's continued attention to the vessel's mechanical systems and reliability.

Significant Recent Upgrades

One of the biggest advantages of this yacht is the substantial investment that has already been made in updating important onboard systems. Recent improvements and equipment include:
